Please note that the Faculty/Staff/Student Collection is **not** intended to be:

- 1. An archive of any author's papers.
- 2. A collection that includes all publications written by a member of the Flagler family.
- 3. A collection that is likely to ever be digitized.
- 4. A depository of digital documents.

The Faculty/Staff/Student Collection is:

- 1. A collection of books authored by a current or past member of the faculty, adjunct faculty, staff, and eventually the student and alumni bodies.
- 2. A collection of books that includes a contribution by a current or past member of the faculty, adjunct faculty, staff, and eventually the student and alumni bodies.
- 3. A collection that is distinct/separate from the circulating collection as it will be in all possible cases a signed copy of the book. This collection is not available for check-out.

Professors who retire from Flagler College and are honored with the distinction of "Emeritus" may consult with the Director of Library Services and the Special Collections Librarian about donating a copy of all of their publications (books, journals with articles, poetry contributions, newspaper articles, etc.) that are in a print format. These "Emeritus" status individuals who wish to have a copy of their published documents saved by Flagler College will be reviewed and negotiated on an individual-by-individual case-basis.
